Robert James Wright, Sr.

To Everything There is a Season. Ecclesiastes 3:1

A Time to Be Born

Robert James Wright was born on Mother's day, May 9, 1937. He was a twin; his brother died in childbirth. Their parents were William G. Wright, Sr and Edna Mae Wright.

A Time to Plant

Robert was educated in the Hillsborough County school system, having attended Dunbar Elementary Carver Junior High, and graduated from Middleton Senior High - Class of 1957. He worked at Booker and Company for many years. He began working there at a low entry level position and worked his way to the top as a Materials and Sales Manager before retiring. That speaks of his dedication and determination.

A Time to Build up

He was a life member of Mt. Olive AME Church, Tampa, and was proud to be one of the oldest and longest members there. At Mt. Olive AME Church he served in various positions, including class leader, Trustee, and Steward. He was a Sunday School teacher of the young adults and adult classes for over fifty years and served as Sunday School superintendent for 27 and a half years. He worked on the building committee for the new church.

He chaired the Lay Organization's Hymn-O-Rama at Mt. Olive for close to thirty years. In 2005, Rev. James Givens named the local Lay Organization the Favors-Wright Lay Organization. Always at the forefront of engagement, Mr. Wright was elected president of the city-wide male chorus which had over 50 men in the choir. He served as president of the Tampa District Lay Organization of the AME Church for a total of 23 years and remained a strong lay person until his death. He was the first to have a district convention. Mr. Wright served as chairman of the Eleventh Episcopal District Lay Organization Legislative Committee and as a member of the Connectional Lay Organization's Legislative Committee. He was elected as a conference trustee for many years, and sat on the Enterprise Board of the Eleventh Episcopal District. In addition, he was elected a delegate to the General Conference of the AME Church. Mr. Wright received many awards from churches near and far.

Robert Wright was well known and revered in the AME Church at all levels. Bishops knew his name and held him in high regard, yet he never lost the common touch. He remained faithful to God and loved his church to the end of his life.

A Time to Cast Away Stones and A Time to Gather Stones Again

Mr. Wright took his civic responsibility seriously. He found time to serve on jury duty for Hillsborough County four times. He served as jury foreman three times.

Mr. Wright's mom already had a son called 'Billy,' and she called her second living son 'Bobby." Mr. Wright's grandmother, upon seeing her new born grandchild remarked, "You are one white rat!" And the rest is history, as that stuck as a nickname.

Mr. Wright was married to his 'Doll' Archia Wright for 57 years, and they were the parents of 3 sons: Algernon, Robert Jr. and Keith.















